



Fish Tank

(Remember always ask permission and clean up after you are done)



Materials Needed:

Rectangular tissue box
Paint or paper to cover the box
A fish to trace
5 eyes
5 bendable straws
Glue
Scissors

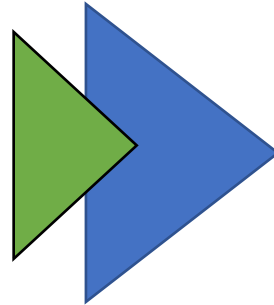
Directions:



Cut a rectangle window in your box. Leaving approximately a one inch frame around the box opening. Paint or paper your box two shades of blue or whatever color you select. It's a fish tank.



Create a fish. I drew two triangles of different sizes and then put them together. I used this to trace 5 fish additional fish.



Use bright colors for your fish. You will need 5 fish in all. Glue an eye on each fish on both sides. Decorate both sides of your fish. The fish will be able to swivel so both sides of the fish will show.



Use a pencil, make a 5 holes in the top of your box. Offset the holes by alternating front and back.



Insert the 5 straws in the holes, with the bendable portion at the top.



Glue your fish to the straws. Glue them at different heights and different directions.



Make some seaweed by cutting out wavy pieces of green paper. Glue them to the inside front opening. Twist the straws to make your fish swim.
