

Zip-line

(Remember always ask permission and clean up after you are done)

Materials Needed:

Fishing line or other string that can go through a straw

Straw

Paper cups

A high and low place not too far apart (from the top of a chair to the ground, the top of a dresser to the ground, you get the idea)

Tape – masking or duct tape

Directions:

- Attach one end of your string to the lower point.
- Slip the string through your one inch piece of straw
- Attach the string to the upper point which forms your zip-line.
- Now you figure out how to attach the paper cup to the straw. You want your straw to move freely up and down the string. This is your zip-line.
- Once your cup is attached put something in it and see if it can carry the object or liquid from the top to the bottom.
- How can you improve your zip-line? Do you think the type of string you use makes a difference?
- Can you make it longer? faster? slower?
- Can your zip-line carry a stuffed animal?
